- SEEN FROM EU AND DENMARK

Danes Worldwide invites to a lecture and discussion focusing on the impact Brexit will have on Denmark and Danes.

Two experts will share their insights - Ambassador Claus Grube and Professor Marlene Wind. Moderator: Jakob Moll, Journalist and CEO of Zetland.

Claus Grube has served as the Permanent Representative to the EU in Brussels, as Permanent Secretary of State at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and most recently as Ambassador to the UK (during the Brexit vote).

Marlene Wind is professor at the Department of European Science and heads up the Centre for European Politics carrying out research in the area of EU treaties and the institutional evolution of the EU.

A brief overview of Brexit will be presented, followed by a discussion of the current outlook: What implications will there be for Danes in Denmark and abroad - e.g. for families, students, and employees in the UK and for enterprises doing business in the UK and stationing staff members there?
