All educational products

Recommended devices

Computers:

- **PC, Windows 7** or above.
- Mac, Apple OS X

Tablets:

- **iPad 3** or above, **iPad Mini** or **iPad Pro** (**Notice: Beginner Danish 13+** and **Beginner Danish 6-12** are exceptions to this, as Flash-based content is no longer fully supported on iOS. We are working on a solution).

Other:

- **iPhones** can be used to the same extent as iPads, but we do not recommend these because of the small screen size.

We do not recommend:

- **Android, Windows and Kindle Fire mobile devices.** We cannot guarantee full functionality on these devices, but you are welcome to try our demo versions to see if your Android/Windows device supports our products.

In general, we recommend a **screen size** of no less than 7,9 inches (20x13,4cm).

Browsers & Software

School Danish, Basic Danish and Beginner Danish 6-12 only require the newest version of Chrome, Safari or Firefox.

Beginner Danish 13+ requires use of Chrome because of its use of Googles voice-synchronization program.

We cannot guarantee support for Internet Explorer, Microsoft Edge or Opera along with any other mobile browser or anything else not mentioned here.

Microphone, Camera and Keyboard

All of our products require use of a microphone and a camera for assignments and voice-synchronization. Most all microphones and cameras are suitable, and headsets for mobile devices along with cameras in these are sufficient, along with integrated cameras and microphones in laptops. **Beginner Danish 13+** might require a relatively quiet space to work in depending on microphone quality, as the voice-synchronization program we use can be upset by noise.

We recommend using a **keyboard with the Danish letters Ææ, Øø and Åå**. If you are unable to acquire such a keyboard, there are several options:

1. Set the keyboard layout on a mobile device to Danish. You may need to download and install the Danish keyboard layout.
2. On a PC/Mac, use the screen keyboard to insert the special Danish letters by clicking on them.
3. On a PC/Mac, reassign keys that are rarely used (for example, reassign the & symbol to represent æ). This may require the installation of Danish as a language option on your device.
4. While we do accept the use of *ae*, *oe* and *aa* as replacements for Danish letters, we do not recommend this approach in that the special Danish letters are an integral part of the language.
